



IMMUNIZATION AND TB SKIN TEST NOTICE

California law requires all students to provide documentation showing proper vaccinations. Students must have the following immunizations in order to attend San Joaquin Memorial:

Hepatitis A (HepA): Two doses of HepA are required after age two. Each of the two doses must be given at least 6 months apart from each other.

Hepatitis B (HepB): Three doses of HepB are required. The second dose must be given one to two months after the first dose. The third dose must be given four to six months after the first dose.

Inactivated poliovirus (IPV): Four doses of the polio vaccine are required. One dose must be received after student's fourth birthday.

Tetanus, diphtheria, & acellular pertussis (Tdap): A Tdap vaccine is required and must have been received within the past five years. Tdap is NOT the same as the Td or DTP vaccinations. In most cases, Tdap will need to be administered upon arrival in Fresno, CA.

Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR): Two doses of MMR vaccine are required with the first dose after the first birthday. The second dose is to be administered twenty-eight or more days later or physician verification of disease.

Varicella (VAR): Two doses of Varicella vaccine are required in US with first dose after the first birthday and second dose twenty-eight days later, or a physician verification of disease with month, day, year clearly noted.

Note: All students must have their official vaccinations transcribed by the local Department of Health, which will determine whether all immunizations are up-to-date.
Students will not be allowed to start school without documentation from the Department of Health.

All students attending Memorial must present evidence of a TB Skin test. A written form must be submitted demonstrating:

- Type of test (PPD only)
- Date administered
- Skin test results
- Signature of doctor or designee
