**Summer School 2022 will be offered Monday-Friday from
June 13 through July 22
(Hybrid Instruction)**

Courses offered for grade recovery:

**Algebra 1P and Geometry P
General Religion**

Students who have earned an F or D in either semester are eligible for summer school. Students will only be allowed to enroll in two courses; however, special circumstances may allow for three. All courses are enrollment-based; therefore, summer school courses will only be offered if the class has seven or more students enrolled.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **What will summer school look like this year?**

Summer school will be hybrid for math because of the benefits it can provide students needing hands-on math instruction. Religion will operate as an Independent Study course. See course descriptions for more details.

- **What will each day look like?**

Courses will be scheduled for specific dates and times. See the course description and times included in this handout. Although students will be receiving in-person instruction, they will be expected to do about 3-5 hours of work per week outside of class time.

- **What are the dates and times for summer school?**

Summer school will run from June 13 through July 22. Dates and times vary depending on the course. Scroll down to the "Courses Offered" section to view the dates and times for each course.

- **Who should take these summer school courses?**

Anyone who earned a D+ or below in a semester course should plan on making up that semester during summer school. Grade recovery allows students to get back on their college track and improves their semester grade point average (GPA). In addition, it will allow many students to regain their eligibility to run for class office, participate in clubs and activities, and return to athletics.

COURSES OFFERED

- **Algebra 1P (5 credits) Hybrid** (M,W,F Virtual; T,TH In-Person)

June 13 - July 1, 2022 (Semester 1) *(July 4 is a school holiday)*

July 5 - July 22, 2022 (Semester 2)

10:00 A.M. - 12:00 P.M.

Cost: \$300 per semester

This course is the equivalent of a full semester of college preparatory, high school Algebra 1. This course is designed for students who earned a D+ or below in the previous school year in either the fall or spring semester. Counselors will advise students, with the approval of the Dean for Academics, the semester grade being replaced or if both semesters are needed.

- **Geometry P (5 credits) Hybrid** (M,W,F Virtual; T,TH In-Person)

June 13 - July 1, 2022 (Semester 1) *(July 4 is a school holiday)*

July 5 - July 22, 2022 (Semester 2)

9:00 A.M. - 11:00 A.M.

Cost: \$300 per semester

This course is the equivalent of a full semester of college preparatory high school Geometry. This course is designed for students who earned a D+ or below in the previous school year in either the fall or spring semester. Counselors will advise students, with the approval of the Dean for Academics, the semester grade being replaced or if both semesters are needed.

- **General Religion (5 credits) Independent Study**

June 13 - July 1, 2022 (Semester 1) *(July 4 is a school holiday)*

July 5 - July 22, 2022 (Semester 2)

Time: This is an independent study course and will be scheduled at the instructor's discretion.

Cost: \$300 per semester

Grade Level: Current 9th - 11th

This course is for students who are deficient in any religion course. Students will work with their instructor to review the basic content from each respective religion course needing credit recovery. Counselors will advise students, with the approval of the Dean for Academics, the semester grade being replaced or if both semesters are needed.

<p>All students enrolled in summer school may drop a course up until the third class session with no academic penalty or grade reflection. After this date students will have a grade reported for the course taken. Students are allowed one class absence per course with no penalty; however, all class absences must be communicated with the instructor. Course Syllabus will be provided.</p>
